## FOOD SECURITY SECTOR CASH DASHBOARD - NORTH EAST NIGERIA


As of May 2018, the Food Security Sector assisted **3,358,336** unique individuals of which **43%** were assisted through cash based transfers including vouchers and electronic vouchers. Of those assisted with cash-based transfers, 70% were for SO1 (Food Assistance), with 30% for SO2 (Agriculture and Livelihoods). Restricted transfer (such as vouchers and electronic vouchers) was the most commonly used cash modality in May. Assistance was also delivered through conditional transfer (cash for work/assets/training) in Borno State.





