Context and iMMAP Inc. Approach



The DR Congo faces a multitude of challenges, including pervasive insecurity in the east, recurring natural disasters, and frequent infectious disease outbreaks. These crises result in significant displacement and exacerbate existing problems. Despite some health improvements, the country continues to grapple with substantial healthcare needs.



iMMAP Inc's mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) is to provide critical Information Management (IM) support to the Health Cluster partners and members, including the World Health Organization (WHO), the Cluster Lead Agency.

The Goals of this project is offering impartial, accurate, and timely IM support, coordination within the DRC's health cluster will improve significantly. This, in turn, will enhance life-saving activities, targeting, contextual analysis, and decision-making processes related to health emergencies in the DRC.



Our comprehensive approach includes services in coordination, technical support, and data analysis. This support extends to sub-national coordination platforms across various DRC regions. iMMAP's services encompass the creation of interactive dashboards, spatial analysis, mapping, coordination tools, and assistance in defining needs assessments to understand the context and situational awareness of health-related emergencies. Additionally, they support the development and implementation of monitoring and evaluation tools for assessing the impact of health preparedness and response measures in the DRC.

Since 2019, iMMAP Inc. has played an essential role in supporting humanitarian projects addressing these challenges in the Democratic Republic of Congo, particularly in the health sector.



Our contributions span from providing information system management for Ebola response strategies, collaborating on the Go.Data project for epidemic investigations, to generating monthly situation analysis reports on COVID-19's humanitarian impact in DRC. These efforts have not only deepened the understanding of DRC's humanitarian crisis but have also enhanced the efficiency and effectiveness of response efforts.

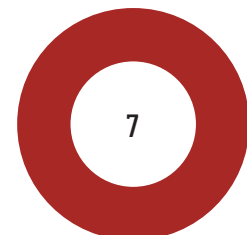
