




PEOPLE REACHED by CLUSTER/WORKING GROUPS


Total number of services provided



Based on data extracted from ReportHub, the number of people reached with different services decreased from 18.1M in December 2022 to 14.3M in January 2023. In January, a total of 176 projects were active, 40 of which catered to COVID-19 response. The FSA Cluster reported the highest number of people reached with services (11.7M). The Health Cluster has the most active projects (79) and reported the highest number of locations/sites where different health activities have been conducted (4,465), while Foood Assistance is reported to be addressed by FSA Cluster partners with 516 services/activities mostly to the IPC Phase 3 affected population.

This dashboard provides a snapshot of 5W data in Afghanistan as reported to **ReportHub** by implementing partners during the period. By analyzing and visualizing information related to projects, activities (including COVID-19-related activities), and services to beneficiaries, the dashboard aims to assist humanitarian actors in Afghanistan by helping them to identify patterns, trends, and gaps in their responses. This information can be used by partners to inform their decisions related to either re-aligning, re-programing, or planning their projects and activities.
