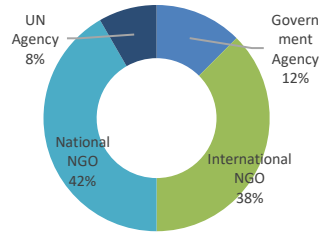

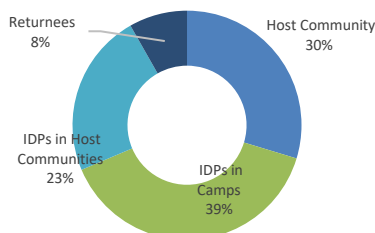

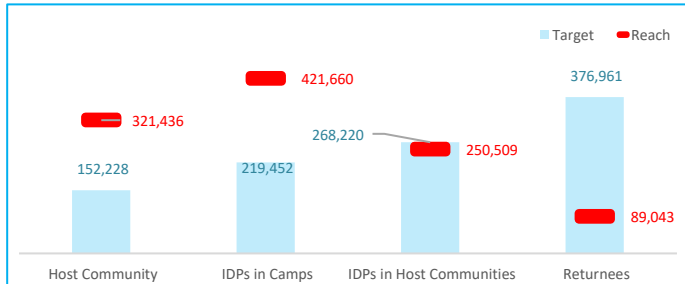
Type of Partners



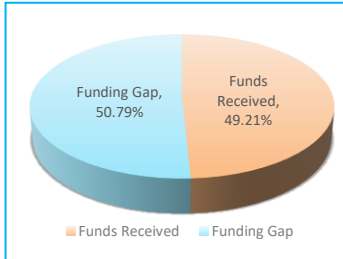
Population Coverage



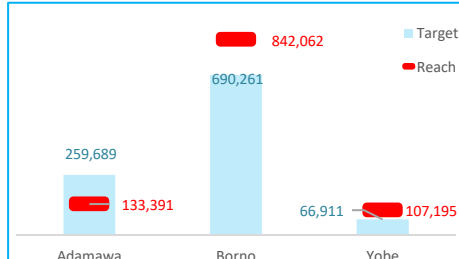
Population Coverage - Target & Reach



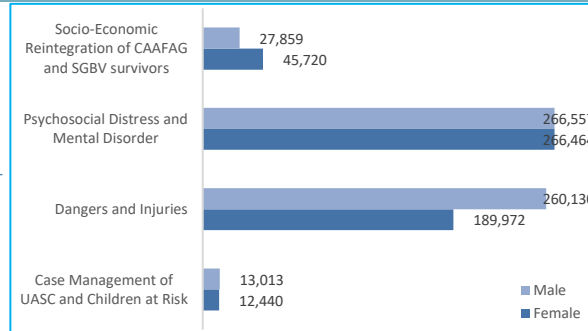
Funding Status



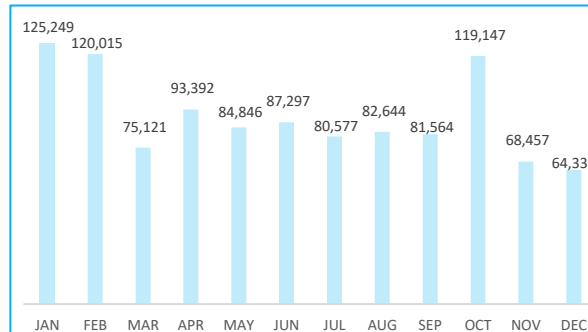
State Wise Target and Reach



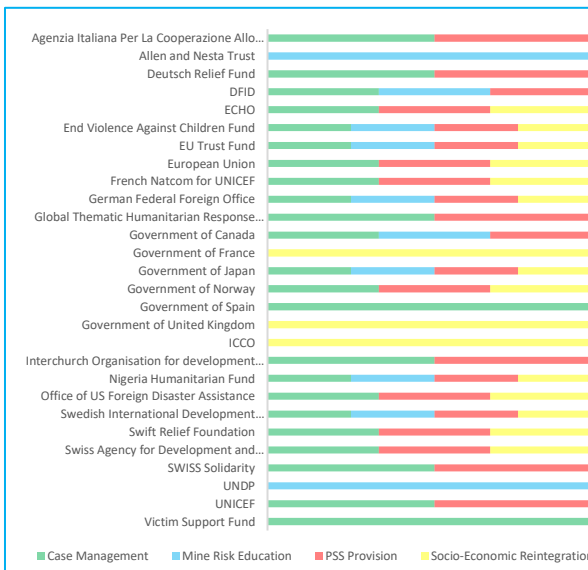
Beneficiaries by CP Core Commitments
